

### **World Chess Master visits the High Commission**

The Acting High Commissioner, His Excellency, Mr. Adah Simon Ogah was paid a courtesy call by Mr. John Fawole, a Nigerian World Chess Master on 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2016.

Mr Fawole participated in the 40<sup>th</sup> Hampstead Congress held at Henderson Court Resource Centre, London on 11-12 June, 2016 and won the U2200 section outright (1<sup>st</sup> Position). The tournament helped raise money for Age UK Camden, a charity which supports the elderly. He would be going to Uganda in July this year to compete for the title of Grand Master.

His Excellency, an avid chess player said he was delighted to meet Mr. Fawole, adding “I must congratulate you most warmly on your illustrious achievements which I have followed with keen interest”. Mr Ogah recounted his first meeting with Mr Fawole when he was Minister, Head Information, Culture and Sports at the High Commission.
