

Acting High Commissioner calls for full participation of the Private Sector

Nigeria's Acting High Commissioner to the United Kingdom, Mr Adah Simon Ogah has called on Nigerian business leaders in the private sector of the economy to double their efforts in attracting investments to Nigeria and not to rely on government or diplomatic missions alone.

His Excellency made the call on 25 May, 2017 when he was paid a courtesy call by Asiwaju Fola Osibo, Chairman, Export Committee, Nigerian-British Chamber of Commerce and Mr Akin Olawore, Deputy President of the chamber on tour of private and public sector companies in the UK with some members of the chamber. His Excellency said: "I hope your visit to the UK will offer the chamber the opportunity of interacting with various sectors of the British economy and will be mutually beneficial for our people." He added: "...you must double your efforts if we are to attract investors to Nigeria and if we are to compete with major economies don't to leave it to government".
